Dear Friends of Trinity Baptist Church,
Hello! My name is Ryan Moore. I am a Campus Missionary at the University of Oregon. I have been working on campus for 11 years and have a calling to help students discover Jesus and what it means to be His disciple. Two years ago I worked full time through the Northwest Baptist Convention as a campus minister, but budget cuts and changes in direction left college ministry out of their budget. Now my wife and I raise support in order to continue the work God has called us to. It is exciting to see God work in the hearts of students. A couple of weeks ago a young man, who had found my number through the campus government office, called me. He said he was at the end of his rope, having had a tremendous problem with drinking. He felt like God was giving him another chance, and he was ready to change. I called a friend of mine who leads a recovery group and got him connected. He has gone to an AA meeting every day since and has started going to church again! Praise God for His amazing transformation!

FROM THE PASTOR

Two words come to my mind in reading the New Testament, especially the book of Acts. The first is "evangelism.." The word really is a passionate word. While we say it means good news, we also understand it is the story of the crucifixion of Jesus and His resurrection. The story of the early church is a story of Christians telling the story of Jesus and their personal experience in becoming followers and disciples of the resurrected Christ. I see in the narrative the distance Phillip was willing to go, the price Stephen was willing to pay, the influence and ministry of Barnabas. Christians pursued taking the good news to others.

The second word is "congregationalize." While that word might be new to your vocabulary, it is the result of evangelism. In Scripture when a city or community received the gospel and there were converts they gathered together to form the nucleus of a church.

Trinity Baptist has a rich heritage of being the church on the corner of 12th and B Street. Her legacy includes many baptisms and Bible studies. Trinity's story includes helping the world know Jesus. In her past she helped start new churches. Is it time to recapture the purpose of evangelism and the natural result of establishing a new congregation?
